Winter Workshop is \$775 for tuition and full meal plan. Meal service begins with dinner on Sunday, Jan 15, 2012, and ends with breakfast on Saturday, Jan 21, 2012. Payment is by check or money order only. May be paid in full or on the following payment schedule: \$400 deposit with application - \$375 2nd payment rec'd by Nov. 15

After Nov. 15, payment in full must be made with application. Checks, money orders or Visa/Mastercard accepted. Credit card payments cannot be accepted prior to November 15, 2011.

Refund & Cancellation Policy: Cancellations made in writing by Sept 30 are subject to a \$100 non-refundable cancellation fee. On or after October 1, 2011 no refunds will be made.

Application for On-site Housing at Atlantic Center for the Arts

On-site housing is very popular — and very limited. If you plan to stay on-site, apply now!

Only 26 housing units are available to students and five others are reserved for instructors.

Three types of on-site student housing units are available at ACA:

- 1) Room with one double bed and a private bathroom w/shower
- 2) Room with two beds, 1 double bed and 1 twin bed, private bathroom w/shower, handicapped accessible
- 3) Private Cottage: The ultimate workshop retreat with upper level bedroom with queen bed, private bathroom, living room with queen sofa sleeper, fully equipped kitchen, washer/dryer, porch/deck.

All units have individual heating and A/C control, desk/countertop, refrigerator, clock radio, bed & bath linens, soap and toilet tissue. There are no TVs, no Wi-Fi or computer connections, cellular service is spotty and there is no maid service. (Wi-Fi and cell reception is available in and around classrooms) ACA is a no-frills retreat, so it does not have the amenities you would expect at a motel/hotel/resort, such as shampoo, hair dryer, etc., so pack accordingly. What it lacks in luxury it makes up for in convenience.

Smoking is not permitted in rooms or surrounding area. Smoke only in designated areas on campus.

Units may be shared, but each has only one set of towels and one replacement set. There are no extra towels, blankets, pillows, soap, etc., available, so come prepared.

We'll reserve each unit in one name, but let us know the names of your companions to be sure no one has "double booked." Each unit has only one key and that key will only be given to the person making the reservation or person(s) designated in writing by the main renter.

Rental package is for six nights and cannot be prorated. Check-in is available after 3:00 pm. Sunday. Lodging includes Sunday through Friday night. Breakfast is served Saturday morning. Check-out is 10:00 am Saturday morning.
